OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD: Samaritan’s Purse and OCC are all about sending the gospel to the ends of the earth. OCC Boxes go to places where less than 3% are Christian. There is now a great effort going to more than 1,000 Pacific Islands. Please pray that the recipients of our boxes will come to know Jesus.

There are examples of the gospel materials used in connection with OCC on a table in the back hallway. Please feel free to examine them. They are printed in over 70 languages. Many OCC Box recipients attend a 12-session course. In 2020, over 3.5 million children participated in this Bible study. Over 1.3 million came to faith in Christ.

For every \$9 donation, \$6 goes toward gospel materials.


